Carbon Footprint:

- **Scope 1:** All direct GHG emissions.
- **Scope 2:** Indirect GHG emissions from consumption of purchased electricity, heat or steam.
- **Scope 3:** Other indirect emissions, such as the extraction and production of purchased materials and fuels, transport-related activities in vehicles not owned or controlled by the reporting entity, electricity-related activities not covered in Scope 2, outsourced activities, waste disposal, etc.
